# Dear Collectors

Welcome to the September–October edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, and to a range of new stamp issues and products. Several of these stamp issues mark significant historical and cultural events.

In early September we mark the 50th anniversary of the arrival of a carbonaceous chondrite meteorite with a single-stamp issue. After an explosion and sonic boom, several hundred small meteorite fragments fell around the northern Victorian town of Murchison, an amount of which was recovered and is now held in various scientific institutions. Later in September, we release two large-denomination stamps to cover a rise in international postage rates. They feature views of Sydney city and harbour, and the Elizabeth Quay, on Perth's riverfront.

One of the most infamous events in maritime history was the mutiny on the HMS *Bounty*, in 1789. We recognise this through a Norfolk Island stamp issue, part of our territories program. The stamp designs present the mutineers on the \$2 stamp and the casting adrift of Captain Bligh and others on the \$1 stamp.

An issue for release in early October commemorates the Great Air Race of 1919, for which £10,000 was offered to the first Australian crew to fly from England to Australia within 30 days.

The issue's double-commemorative \$3.20 stamp recognises that the first overseas airmail to arrive in Australia was carried on board this historic flight. Two Royal Australian Mint coins in PNCs associated with this issue introduce an exclusive Australia Post Privy Mark.

Another two-stamp issue for release in early October recognises a significant cultural milestone in Australia. Marriage equality was achieved after a successful referendum led to amending the 1961 *Marriage Act*.

Seed banking is crucial insurance policy in the conservation of native flora species and the resilience of our botanical world. This practice is recognised through the three stamp designs in the Seed Banking Australia issue. And also for release in October is our final instalment in the popular Fair Dinkum Aussie Alphabet series. I hope you enjoy the playful designs for outstanding letters: D, F, H, I, M and P.

# Murchison Meteorite 1969–2019

About 80 kilograms from the Murchison meteorite are held in scientific collections in Australia and throughout the world, with significant collections at Museums Victoria in Melbourne.

On Sunday, 28 September 1969, at about 10:50am, a meteorite shower fell around the town of Murchison, some 160 kilometres north of Melbourne, Victoria. Witnesses described it as “an enormous, great ball of fire”.

Following the explosion and sonic boom, several hundred small meteorite fragments fell around the township. At least 100 kilograms of these fragments were recovered from an area of about 350 square kilometres.

The Murchison meteorite belongs to a rare class of meteorite called a carbonaceous chondrite. These meteorites are considered very “primitive”, meaning they retain chemical properties from their time of formation some 4.56 billion years ago. Due to its rarity and the amount of material recovered, Murchison is one of the most extensively studied meteorites known.

Murchison contains an abundance of organic compounds including over

90 amino acids, the building blocks of our DNA, many of which are not found on Earth. It is generally accepted that these organic compounds in Murchison have formed through non-biological processes. They do, however, indicate that the carbon building blocks of life may be readily abundant in space. It has been postulated that meteorites may well have “seeded” life on Earth by bringing such compounds with them.

Murchison meteorite is a rich source of “pre-solar” mineral grains. These grains formed in star systems and exploding star supernovae events from billions of years before our Sun and solar system formed. Microdiamonds and silicon carbide are among the most commonly extracted, but there are many other compounds known. Understanding the composition of pre-solar grains helped to determine how the various elements of the Periodic Table have formed within stars.





These International stamp designs promote Australia's beautiful cities and points of interest to the rest of the world.

This issue is the second in a series featuring Australian cities. Based on a number of indices, including political and economic stability, environmental integrity and access to public transport and recreation, our major cities are consistently named among the world's most liveable. The first issue in 2018 featured Adelaide, South Australia, Brisbane, Queensland and Melbourne, Victoria.

The city of Sydney, New South Wales, was established in 1788 on the lands of the Gadigal people of the Eora nation. With more than five million residents, today Sydney is the most populous of our state capitals.

The stamp shows the famous Sydney Opera House, situated on Bennelong Point on the spectacular Sydney Harbour.

The largest state by area, Western Australia occupies approximately a third of the continent. The capital city of Perth, located on the beautiful Swan River and bounded by the Indian Ocean, was established in 1829 on the lands of the Whadjuk Noongar people. With around 2.3 million inhabitants, Perth has the fourth largest population of cities in Australia. The stamp shows Elizabeth Quay, named in honour of Queen Elizabeth II during her Diamond Jubilee.





# Norfolk Island Mutiny on the *Bounty*

The Mutiny on the *Bounty* remains one of the most infamous events in maritime history.

The mutiny on the Royal Navy vessel HMS *Bounty* is the most famous founding narrative of Norfolk Island and one of the most infamous events in maritime history. It occurred in the South Pacific Ocean on 28 April 1789, when unhappy crew members, led by Acting Lieutenant Fletcher Christian, seized control of the ship from their captain, William Bligh, setting him and his 18 supporters adrift in a longboat. Many of the mutineers settled on Tahiti and Pitcairn Island.


Today many Norfolk Islanders can trace their ancestry back to the mutiny in 1789. The descendants of the *Bounty* mutineers and their Tahitian consorts include the modern-day Pitcairn Islanders as well as a little less than half of the population of Norfolk Island. Some of the mutineers' names are still carried by island residents, including Christian, Young, Adams, Quintal and McCoy.

The stamps and minisheet design reproduces a hand-coloured aquatint engraving made by English artist Robert Dodd in 1790. This copy of the aquatint is held in the National Library of Australia.

The aquatint was issued in October 1790, only a few months after the first printing of Bligh's account of the mutiny. It shows Bligh and his men being cast adrift in the longboat. At the moment depicted, the painter or rope of the longboat is still attached to the ship, and the four swords reluctantly allowed to the men in the longboat are about to be thrown to them. That Dodd's sympathies lay with Bligh is made further evident in the caption, which notes that the men in the open boat "sustained life under divine providence for 41 days".



Marriage in Australia was legally defined as a union between a man and a woman in 2004. Same-sex unions were treated as de facto unions under federal law. These unions provided couples with most, though not all, of the legal rights of marriage, although those rights may be difficult to assert and were not always recognised in practice.

A voluntary postal survey, designed to gauge support for same-sex marriage and the removal of legal discrimination was held between 12 September and 7 November 2017. The survey returned 7,817,247 (61.6%) "Yes" responses and 4,873,987 (38.4%) "No" responses. An additional 36,686 (0.3%) responses were unclear and the total turnout was 12,727,920 (79.5%).

This important survey closed on 7 November 2017 and the results were released on 15 November 2017.

Liberal senator Dean Smith introduced a historic marriage equality bill to the Australian parliament and senators from across the spectrum rose to endorse it just a day after the release of the survey results.

Legislation to allow same-sex marriage, the *Marriage Amendment (Definition and Religious Freedoms) Act 2017*, passed the Australian Parliament on 7 December 2017 and received royal assent from the Governor-General the following day. The law came into effect on 9 December, immediately recognising overseas same-sex marriages. The first same-sex wedding under Australian law was held on 15 December 2017.

The stamp designs are celebratory, showing the highly recognisable rainbow colours and slogans synonymous with the Marriage Equality campaign.

The \$1 stamp in this issue shows the crew in front of the *Vimy*, prior to it being painted with its lettering "G-EAOU", which Ross Smith is said to have joked stood for "God 'Elp All of Us".

The Ross Smith label, featured on the \$3.20 stamp, was placed on each piece of airmail carried on board the epic flight.

At the conclusion of World War I, Australia's wartime prime minister, William "Billy" Hughes, became fascinated with aviation, enjoying several flights while attending the Paris Peace Conference in January 1919. A couple of months later, the Hughes government announced what became known as the Great Air Race: the offer £10,000 to the first Australian to successfully fly from England to Australia within 30 days.

The victorious crew was led by Captain Ross Smith of the Australian Flying Corps, a 26-year-old highly decorated pilot and World War I veteran. Smith's assistant pilot and navigator was his brother Lieutenant Keith Smith. The mechanics were Sergeants Walter "Wally" Shiers and James Bennett, both of whom had worked alongside Ross Smith during the war. The Vickers Aircraft Company made available to its newly developed twin-engine *Vimy* heavy bomber aircraft.

On the morning of 12 November 1919, Captain Ross Smith's

Vickers *Vimy* departed Hounslow Aerodrome, London, despite it being covered with snow. Poor and ever-changing weather was an ongoing challenge throughout the flight. Nevertheless, Ross Smith and his crew successfully landed at Fannie Bay airfield, Darwin, on 10 December, a little under 28 days later. Upon exiting the plane, the men were flooded by enthusiastic well-wishers, including distinguished pilot Lieutenant Hudson Fysh, who went on to establish Qantas in November 1920 and who had helped to survey the race route in Australia. The £10,000 prize money was shared equally by the four crew members.

Ross Smith and crew had flown an incredible distance of almost 17,800 kilometres (11,060 miles) – incredible, because the previous record was just over 5,000 kilometres. The men were hailed as heroes in Australia and internationally. On board the flight was the first international airmail to reach Australia. Hundreds of covers were taken from England, with others handed in along the route.





Flourishing and diverse plant species are crucial to our existence, being the source of fresh air, food, medicines, shelter, environmental health and more. But factors such as climate change, over-exploitation, salinity and landscape fragmentation all impact greatly on the survival of both wild and cultivated plant species.

Seed banking has been established in several countries as an insurance against species extinction, and as a source of quality seed for use in restoring depleted plant communities and habitats. Australia is home to several seed banks,

most of which are associated with botanical gardens. These organisations collect, conserve and research flora species to ensure the continuing diversity and resilience of our botanical world. They also contribute to the world's largest seed bank, the Millennium Seed Bank Partnership of the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, in the UK, which effectively functions as an offsite back-up for our national seed collections.

The stamps in this issue feature the seeds of three native species, each of which is at risk.

The background element and the typographic style used in the stamps suggest banknote design, helping to indicate the concepts of "value", "currency" and "banking".



It also features Freddy's father, a fanatical Freo fan, who fantasises fully about fishing. He frequently tells Freddy some furrphies about fish, and Freddy unfaithfully falls hook, line and sinker.


